Day 1 Arrival in Nairobi

After breakfast at the hotel, set off for a day tour (sightseeing) in Nairobi including visits to The Giraffe Center, Utamaduni Craft Center, Kobe Tough Beads & Bomas of Kenya.

Transfer back to the Hotel in the afternoon to freshen up for your welcome dinner at Fogo Gaucho Restaurant.

DAY 3 Nairobi - Ol Pejeta

After an early breakfast, drive north travelling to Nanyuki onto Ol Pejeta Conservancy. Check-in to Sweetwaters Tented Camp. A sheltered oasis, clustered around a water hole and set in the pristine calm of the private Ol Pejeta Conservancy, Sweetwaters offers a charming blend of under-canvas ambiance and safari luxury. Located on the plains of Mount Kenya, the camp features thirty-nine luxury tents, each with its own private veranda overlooking the water hole.

The central Rhino Restaurant, housed in the former manager's house of this once colonial farm offers both regional and international cuisine.

The Waterhole Bar, built in the style of a game-viewing hide, overlooks the waterhole and offers unrivalled wildlife-watching.

DAY 4 Ol Pejeta

Morning and afternoon game drives.

Visit the local Rhino and Chimpanzee Sanctuaries during your game drives.

About Ol Pejeta Conservancy:

From a working cattle ranch in colonial Kenya, to a trailblazer of conservation innovation - the story of Ol Pejeta is as enchanting as it is inspirational. Today, Ol Pejeta is the largest black rhino sanctuary in east Africa, and home to two of the world's last remaining northern white rhino. It is the only place in Kenya to see chimpanzees, in a Sanctuary established to rehabilitate animals rescued from the black market. It has some of the highest predator densities in Kenya, and still manages a very successful livestock programme. Ol Pejeta also seeks to support the people living around its borders, to ensure wildlife conservation translates to better education, healthcare and infrastructure for the next generation of wildlife guardians.

Overnight: Sweetwaters Serena Camp-Standard Tent

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

DAY 5 Ol Pejeta – Lake Nakuru

After breakfast, depart to Lake Nakuru stopping enroute at Thompson Falls with packed box lunch.

Continue to your lodge at Lake Nakuru. The lodge overlooks Lake Nakuru and its surrounding National Park, one that is a paradise for bird watchers and wildlife lovers alike. Lake Nakuru National Park is mainly a wooded and bushy grassland with a wide ecological diversity and characteristic habitats that range from the lake waters to the escarpment and ridges.

Enjoy an afternoon game drive in the park

About Lake Nakuru-Resting squarely on the floor of the Great Rift Valley and surrounded by the characteristic woody and bushy grassland, her sky mirrored lake waters extending to an expansive mass of semi-alkaline water, Lake Nakuru National Park is a ball of beautiful sights waiting to be explored.

A wide ecological diversity, varied wildlife habitats, plant and animal species await the wild outdoor lovers. The park is a uniquely rewarding game-viewing destination and a successful sanctuary for both the endangered black rhinos and white rhinos

Overnight: Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge

DAY 6 Lake Nakuru

Morning and afternoon game drives.

Lake Nakuru is one of the best places to see white rhino and you may get lucky and see the elusive leopard. Other animals you may see include giraffe, zebra, lion and more. Although the number of flamingoes has gone down there is still a good population to be seen including other bird species such as pelicans.

Lunch will be at the lodge or a picnic box.

Overnight: Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge-Standard room

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

DAY 7 Lake Nakuru – Masai Mara

Leaving the lodge after breakfast, continue the drive to arrive in the famous Masai Mara National Reserve, and Kilima Camp.

Lunch at the camp followed by an afternoon game drive.

Kilima Camp Masai Mara- *Set at an altitude of 1850 meters, the camp has spectacular views of the Maasai Mara and Mara River below. Small and intimate the camp is home away from home*

Masai Mara: World renowned for the breath-taking spectacle of ‘the greatest wildlife shows on earth’, the awe-inspiring annual migration of the wildebeest, the Mara is Kenya’s most visited protected area. Technically an extension of Tanzania’s renowned Serengeti National Park, the Mara constitutes only 4% of the entire Serengeti ecosystem but its rolling grasslands, meandering rivers and towering escarpments offer one of the world’s most rewarding and evocative wildlife arenas.

In the afternoon, enjoy a **game-drive in the Mara** where you may get to see a variety of mammals and bird species.

Returning to the camp, enjoy some relaxation and dinner in the central restaurant.

DAY 8 Masai Mara

Morning and afternoon game drives.

When it comes to game-viewing, there is nowhere in Africa richer in wildlife or more eventful in encounters than the Mara. A pristine wilderness of haunting beauty, it promises its visitors a profusion of wildlife, prolific bird life and the unprecedented opportunity of catching up with all the members of the Big Five' – buffalo, rhino, elephant, lion and leopard.

Overnight: Kilima Camp

DAY 9 Masai Mara

Morning and afternoon game drives.

During your game drives you may get to see lion, leopard, rhino, elephant, giraffe and a variety of plains game. There is also a wide variety of bird species to be seen.

Overnight: Kilima Camp

DAY 10 Masai Mara - Nairobi

Breakfast at the camp before we pack up and depart for our last morning game drive in the Mara to catch our last glimpses of the resident wildlife.

Return to Nairobi and Transfer to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your onward flight. Packed/box lunch is provided en-route to Nairobi.
